

## Wabash County Hospital Safety Orientation

### Emergency Page Numbers (with buzzer)

- 0 + buzzer = Call Operator, Medical Emergency
- 1 + buzzer = Emergency CareCenter (ECC) Medical Emergency
- 2 + buzzer = Internal Incident
- 3 + buzzer = Critical CareCenter (CCC) medical emergency
- 4 + buzzer = Infant/Pediatric Abduction (guard exits & stairwells, detain suspects)
- 5 = **All Clear**
- 6 + buzzer = Tornado (follow procedures)
- 7 + buzzer = External Disaster (assemble in cafeteria immediately)
- 8 + buzzer = Civil Disturbance/Internal
- 9 + buzzer = Fire Alarm Not Working
- 13 + buzzer = Evacuation

### Emergency Telephone Number

- Dial "6" = This call will be routed to the emergency red phone located in registration. State the emergency in a clear, controlled manner. **Do not hang up** until the operator indicates that your message is understood.

### "RACE" Acronym

- R** = Rescue those in immediate danger, move them past a fire barrier door. Be sure the door closes and latches behind you.
- A** = Alarm must be sounded from the nearest pull station. Follow up with a telephone call to the operator. Give complete information, exact location of the fire, the size and type of fire.
- C** = Confine the fire by closing off the immediate area. Be sure all windows and doors are closed as they cause a draft and this fans the fire.
- E** = Extinguish if fire is small. Be sure to use the proper extinguisher. Do not get yourself boxed in, always work with someone.
